


She received her BA in Dramatic Arts from Whitman College and an MFA from UAF. Jackson was the special assistant for international relations to Anchorage Mayor Dan Sullivan and has been an intercultural consultant. She is an honorary member of the Anchorage East Rotary Club.

Jackson will provide a summary of the damage from the 2015 earthquake. Helping Hands for Nepal was one of the first responders on the scence. She will give an overview of aid so far, why it is so slow, and current needs.

This is a village of 1200 sherpas, mostly Tibetan Buddhists.
