Fairbanks North Star Borough Capital Improvement Program Presented by FNSB Mayor Bryce Ward



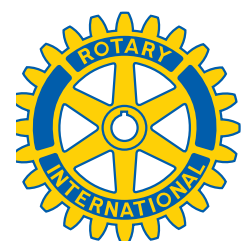
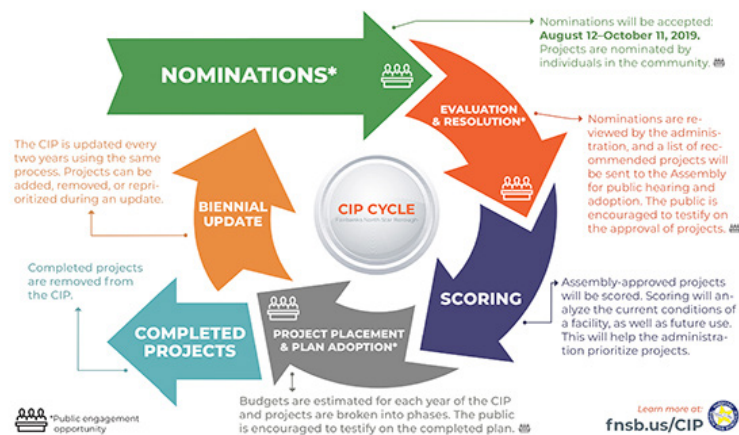
Mayor Bryce J. Ward was born and raised in the interior and has called the Fairbanks-North Pole area home ever since. He was elected as the 12th Mayor of the Fairbanks North Star Borough in October 2018 and is currently serving his first 3-year term as Borough mayor. Mayor Ward is a graduate of Lathrop High School and received his Associates Degree in Business and a Certificate in Management from the University of Alaska Fairbanks Technical College.

Mayor Ward served on the North Pole City Council for one year prior to being elected as Mayor of the City of North Pole and served two consecutive (3-year) terms from October 2012 to October 2018. He is also the owner of Ward Alaska LLC, a small general contracting company, and owns residential rental homes in the North Pole area.

Mayor Ward's civic activities included volunteering with the Boy Scouts of America in Fairbanks/North Pole.
