PRESENTED BY JASON WEINER

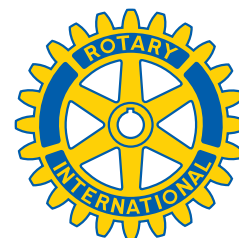
Jason Weiner graduated from Lafayette College in 1994 with degrees in biology and international affairs and a minor in environmental science.
