What is the Rotary Youth Exchange Program?

Rotary International is a network of service clubs around the world dedicated to serving others & advancing international goodwill & understanding. Rotary's motto is Service above Self.

Each year more than 7000 young people have the opportunity of a lifetime— a chance to live in another country & see the world from a new perspective through Rotary Youth Exchange. YOU COULD BE ONE OF THEM!

Rotary Youth Exchange students spend most of a year in a different country living with host families & attending school. They learn a new way of living, a new language & culture, & a great deal about themselves.

As they learn, they also teach the people they meet about Canada & our culture. They become good-will ambassadors, helping to bring the world closer together & making many lifelong friends in the process.

How Does It Work?

Students are hosted by a Rotary club. They stay with 1-4 host families & attend a local school. They are supported by a network of Rotarians both in their own & in their "adopted" countries.

How Are Students Chosen?

Students submit an application. We interview 3-4 (and their parents), & one student is nominated as our exchange student. Rotary District 5370 must then approve the nomination.

Characteristics we are looking for:

- V Be at least 16 yrs old on 30 June 2020 and
- not turn 19 yrs before return in July 2021.
- ✓ Cannot have completed high school.
- V Good character and reputation.
- V Above average academic performance.
- V Has shown leadership in school or community.
- V Is flexible and willing to try new things.
- V Enjoys and is comfortable meeting new people.
- V Comfortable speaking in public.

V Parents whole-heartedly support the exchange.

Student Responsibilities

V Be an excellent ambassador of Canada & Rotary.V Be open to new experiences & cultural differences.

- V Follow program rules & accept the supervision of your host Rotary club & host parents.
- \vee Be an active participant in exchange activities.
- V Be conscientious, courteous, positive & friendly.
- V Be grateful for your experiences & commit to giving back to your hosts & community.
- V Be committed to immersing yourself in the culture & learning/experiencing as much as you can, including becoming fluent in a new language.

What Does It Cost?

Rotary Club of Camrose pays for airfare, insurance & travel documents (except passport). Host Rotary Club provides allowance & host families provide room & board. Student is responsible for clothing, optional trips & activities, \$500 emergency fund & additional spending money. Refundable \$500 deposit required as well as parent attendance at March 2020 orientation & August 2021 welcome back weekends.
