

Rotary District 5370 Youth Exchange Age Criteria Policy:

The minimum age for eligibility is 15 years of age. For the 2016-2017 **Rotary Youth Exchange** applicants will be considered eligible, by District 5370 and all participating clubs, if they are born on or after January 1, 1999.

Call for Applications:

Rotary Club of Edmonton is accepting short applications of interest from students who meet the age eligibility criteria. One successful candidate and an alternate student will be chosen to represent Rotary Club of Edmonton and spend a year abroad during the 2015-2016 school year.

Key Dates:

- **October 7th and 8th**, 6:00 - 7:30 PM – ***Student and Parent Information Nights*** will be held at Rotary District 5370 Office, 16030 104 Ave NW, Edmonton. RSVP for either date by calling (780) 482-5370.

There is nothing to bring but your questions, maybe a notepad, and your parent(s). If you have two at home, best to bring both, please.

- **October 16, 2015– *SHORT Application deadline.*** The Application has two parts: the questionnaire and the school reference form (Form G), which must both be completed, signed and submitted by this date along with your most recent School Progress Report.

Forms are available online, at your Student Affairs Office and in person at the Information Nights.

- **October 24, 2015 – *Rotary Club of Edmonton Interviews.*** A day will be set for panel interviews of selected candidates and their parent(s). It's important all attend (candidate, parent(s).)

At the end of this day, Rotary Club of Edmonton will have chosen its 2016-17 Outbound Student nominee, and an alternate, who will be notified by phone and in writing of the next steps on the journey.

- **December 4, 2015 – *LONG Application deadline.***
- **January 17, 2016 – *District Interviews*** are mandatory for students and parent(s).
- **March 18-20, 2016 - *Spring Orientation*** is held in Edmonton and is mandatory for all Outbound students and their parents.
