Campground Rules

Campground staff have ultimate authority and can create new rules and evict campers to maintain safety.
Staff are volunteers so please show them respect.

Refunds

You are camping and driving in a grassy field which gets muddy when it rains.

1. Before driving into the campground, it is your responsibility to walk into the campground and inspect your campsite (size, location, slope, flooding, and road conditions).
2. If you are unsatisfied with the condition of the campsite, you may request an alternate campsite, or refunds will be provided before you drive onto the campground.
3. After you have driven onto the campground for any reason a refund will not be provided.

General

4. Fires are now prohibited
5. No fireworks, fire-crackers, or explosives
6. No chainsaws, ATV's, dirt bikes, or off-road vehicles
7. No children's pools, hot tubs, water cannons, water balloons, or super-soakers, etc
8. Pets are prohibited
9. Parents must accompany their children to their games; children cannot be left unsupervised in the campground.
10. Glass bottles are prohibited. Broken glass is a major safety concern for pets, children, and clean-up staff.
11. Please keep music volume reasonable.
12. The RCMP, not campground staff, will handle all disagreements between campers.

Vehicles

13. Do not drive through other campsites when parking your vehicles and RV's.
14. You must be able to vacate the campground at any time without disturbing adjacent campsites (i.e. don't box-in your RV).
15. Do not park in driving lanes. Vehicles must be parked entirely inside your campsite boundary.
16. Some driving lanes are one-way. Please follow directions on the map and signs.
17. Do not drive past gate without a vehicle tag. Vehicles inside the campground without a tag will be towed immediately without warning.
18. No vehicle traffic into or within the campground between 11pm and 6am

Fires

19. Fires are now prohibited
20. No liquid fire-starters (gasoline, diesel, butane, etc)
21. RCMP will be called on any open fires.

Showers and Portable Toilets

22. Showers are open 6am to 10pm
23. Please try to keep showers clean
24. The person responsible for tipping a portable toilet will be fined \$100 and his team will be fined an additional \$100.

Terms and Conditions

Rates are posted. Charges are for the use of the assigned site and campground facilities only. The site is for vacation purposes only. Commercial use of campsites is prohibited. The Campground assumes no responsibility through loss of fire, theft, collision or otherwise to the trailer or vehicles or their contents, whether due to negligence or otherwise. Use of the Campground and equipment yourself, your family, and your guests is solely at your own risk and are subject to the Campground Rules, receipt of a true copy which is hereby acknowledged. The Campground, its employees, servants, or agents shall be saved harmless from any claims whether in contract or by tort, by on behalf of all those admitted to the Campground pursuant or because of this agreement. In addition, the set charges shall be paid on registration or as may be otherwise required. The signatory, represents and warrants that he/she is responsible for and signing on behalf of his/her family, party, guests and any other persons accessing the campground with his/her permission or knowledge. Any violation of this agreement, the determination of which shall be the sole discretion of the campground operator shall result in termination of this agreement. Upon termination, the camper, his/her family and guests shall be deemed to be trespassers, under the Trespass to Property Act and the operator is hereby appointed their respective agent for disconnecting services and removal of their trailer, structures and equipment.
