The Rotary Club of Lloydminster is pleased to review your application for our Legacy Community Project funding dollars. Our intent is to provide support to local projects/programs within our community that:

- 1. Positively impact the quality of life in our community.
- 2. Provide significant exposure for Rotary.

The Rotary Club of Lloydminster Criteria for Funding

- 1. Funding application deadline for the Legacy Community Project is March 31, 2024.
- 2. Maximum funding amount to be considered for the Legacy Community Project is up to \$75,000 depending on the project(s).
- 3. We encourage proposals and ideas from individual community members, community organizations or businesses. However, the successful project must be administered by a not for profit or public sector entity. It is expected the approved project will commence in 2024 and be completed within 24 months; however, the Rotary Club of Lloydminster reserves the right to amend this timeline.
- 4. Rotary Club of Lloydminster is seeking transformational projects that will have a great impact on our community. We anticipate that the applicant will have additional funding to contribute through their own efforts and means, and our club also reserves the right to leverage our funding through Rotary matching grant opportunities.
- 5. Applications must be endorsed by an active member of the Rotary Club of Lloydminster.
- 6. Applications can be submitted online, by mail or presented by an active member of the Rotary Club of Lloydminster.
- 7. All proposed projects will be reviewed based solely upon the information provided below as well as any other supporting documentation that is requested and or provided.
- 8. Funding decisions are at the sole discretion of the Rotary Club of Lloydminster. All decisions are final.
- 9. Applicants will be advised of the funding decision relative to their proposal by May 15, 2024. Upon execution of the grant acceptance documentation, funding will be distributed, commencing the onset of the project.
- 10. Should your project proceed to the final round of consideration for funding, you will be required to present your project at a noon meeting of the Rotary Club of Lloydminster. (We meet Monday at 12:00pm at the Bexson Construction Prairie Room at the Lloydminster Exhibition, Lloydminster, SK.).
- 11. At the midpoint of the project, you may be asked to provide an update to our club and at the end of the project you will be expected to give a presentation on the outcomes of the project to the membership of the Lloydminster Rotary Club at one of our regular meetings.
- 12. A written summary/report with a financial report will also be required at the completion of the project/program.
