WHAT IS IT?

WHERE IS IT?

The starting and ending points will be C.M.H.A. Parking Lot (329 Pitt St.); the rest of the day will be all over the place but with enough options to accommodate participants on foot, etc..

WHAT IS THE OBJECTIVE?

To have a 'fun' fundraiser that will promote exploring and learning about our community while discovering some little known facts and places. The funds raised are being donated to C.M.H.A.'s Mental Health education and suicide prevention programs for schools and the new Mental Health wing at Cornwall Community Hospital.

WHO WILL BE INVOLVED?

The objective is to have 20 teams of 2-4 people. It is expected that any participants operating a motorized vehicle to get around will be 18 years of age and older.
