

Criteria for submission of Photos for Rotary Cash Calendar 2022

To be considered, images must meet the following criteria:

- Photos should be of Ottawa and surrounding areas as the Rotary Cash Calendar is a showcase for the region. Preference will be given to images identifiable from Ottawa and the surrounding region that capture the **2022 theme: Ottawa's Nature Path**.
- **Outdoor scenes in the Ottawa area which could include wildlife such as birds, insects or animals.**
- Seasonality plays an important role as we match the season of the photo with the month of the year and so photos from all seasons are requested.
- The photos will need to print well in a 12" x 9.5" high-quality image format; ideally, 8 megapixels or larger in size works well.
- The submitted images should be in landscape orientation; if the original is in portrait orientation, it should be adjusted and cropped to allow printing in a 12" x 9.5" format.
- You or your immediate family member or family affiliation must own the copyright to the photos submitted.
- If the submitted photos include images of people that could be identified, model release statements may be required.
- The closing date for submission of photos is May 31 st, 2021.
- A maximum of five (5) photos will be accepted per photographer.
- Photos can be submitted either by email to rcwocalendar2022@gmail.com or on a flash drive or CD. If these methods prove difficult for you, please contact us.
- By submitting photos in response to this call letter, you are permitting the RCWO to publish all or any of the photos in the 2022 Rotary Cash Calendar. The photographer's name and Rotary Club affiliation will be published with the photograph.
