In addition to providing financial support for community betterment, the Rotary Club of West Ottawa undertakes "hands-on" community service projects; Examples: (a) litter clean-up on a section of Hunt Club Road; (b) conduct of a lecture and demonstration program -- "The ABCs of Fraud" -- to increase awareness of seniors about techniques used by perpetrators of scams and frauds; (c) Shoe Bank - sort shoes for Shoe Bank Canada and hand out at Parkdale Food Centre; (d) Vimy Oak Tree Planting - plant memorial trees propagated from acorns collected in Vimy (e) Prepare individual frozen meals for Parkdale Food Centre;
