In addition to providing financial support for community betterment, the Rotary Club of West Ottawa undertakes "hands-on" community service projects; Examples: (a) litter clean-up on a section of Hunt Club Road; (b) conduct of a lecture and demonstration program -- "The ABCs of Fraud" -- to increase awareness of seniors about techniques used by perpetrators of scams and frauds; (c) Shoe Bank - sort shoes for Shoe Bank Canada and hand out at Parkdale Food Centre & in Nairobi, Kenya; (d) Vimy Oak Tree Planting - plant memorial trees propagated from acorns collected in Vimy (e) Prepare individual frozen meals for Parkdale Food Centre. Rotary club partners include Kanata Sunrise, Ottawa Bytown, Nepean Kanata, Ottawa Stittsville, Orleans, South Nepean, Kemptville, Ottawa South, Ottawa, Ottawa Metro, Arnprior, Carleton Place, D7040 Passport club, Rotaract Clubs of Ottawa and Ottawa Valley.
