

Membership Process

Although we have a formal membership process that we follow it is **VERY SIMPLE for you to undertake the process.**

You begin by being **our guest** at a regular weekly lunch. You will want to decide if you would like to come back and if this club would be a good fit for you.

While you lunch with us - Let us know that you are interested in learning more about what we do and talk to various members of our club. You will quickly discover that none of us are shy about talking about the work we do in the local and international communities.

Once you decide that you would like to be a member of this club, please **complete an application form** – found on the next drop down menu item – and either hand it to any member or the person who brought you or introduced you to the club.

The Membership committee will review your application and ask a Past President to interview you. This is usually an informal meeting for about half an hour to an hour to get to know you a little better and to explain the various aspects and commitments you undertake when you become a Rotarian. And, of course, to answer any questions you may have at that point.

The Past President submits their recommendation. The Board and club members have an opportunity to accept or reject an application – rarely the latter.

Over this review time you are **most welcome to attend our meetings and join in on any projects** that might be happening to further advance your knowledge of how the club operates.

Following acceptance, you would be inducted as a new member.
