Paul gave an interesting talk about the craft beer industry in the Ottawa Region. He started his beer company in April 2010 making ale. Ale is preferred by brewers over

Lager because ale production takes 2 weeks while lager takes 4 weeks. The craft beer industry is very challenging with many companies being bought up by larger beer companies. Beer companies are either very big or very small, He also stated that the" small piece of the pie "that the craft beer industry now has is shrinking. Questions from members followed on the effect of the new regulations regarding beer sales in supermarkets and differences between Quebec and Ontario markets

He was thanked by **Dave Morton** with the usual memento and a donation to End Polio to mark his presentation
