## **CLUB BUDGET**

**President Pardeep** began today's program with a comprehensive review of the Club's Operating Budget. Revenues come from four sources: Dues, Happy Dollars, Past President Draw, and The Website. Expenditures are from International Assessment in USD; District Assessment; Errors & Omission Insurance; "office expenses"; and "other "or various committees" expenses. Following discussion **President Pardeep** requested approval. Members voted to approve the 2018/19 Budget of \$26,790 and a projected surplus of \$2,000.

**Pardeep** was his President comments. He wants us to increase the visibility of all our good works through greater public relations of Rotary in the community. **Luana Achihaei** will head up a district Public Relations Committee. He asked that we review our fundraisers, our meeting costs, our contract with St Elias which is up in December 2019, and he encouraged us become more involved with working collectively with other Clubs.
