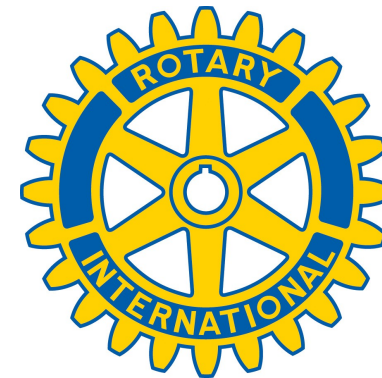

A sampling of completed or current local projects:

- Raised \$50,000 for the Queensway Carleton Hospital Foundation
- Designed, planted, and maintaining the Castlefrank Entrance Gardens in Kanata
- Raised \$24,000 and donated time towards the creation of the Ottawa Rotary Centennial Playground for Children of All Abilities
- Raising \$50,000 toward the capital costs to build a new Ottawa Rotary Home
- Collecting school supplies and backpacks for Kanata school children
- Raising \$50,000 towards building Eastern Ontario Rotary Place, a youth-oriented residential drug treatment centre located in West Ottawa
