- You will be assigned Mentors to aide you throughout your transition into our club.

Once your application passes board approval, the membership will then be given 7 days for any objections, and during that process, an orientation call will be scheduled . We look forward to an opportunity to get to know you better!

ROTARY CLUB OF RED DEER EAST CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

A corporate membership allows corporations, businesses, nonprofits, or government entities an opportunity to participate in Rotary by offering one primary membership package and up to 2 alternatives to some of its chosen employees. Having corporate members increases the club's membership while expanding its network and visibility in the community. Members gain access to the fellowship and service opportunities of Rotary, with the possibility of a much smaller time commitment.

WHY A CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP?

This membership type provides advantages for both clubs and the local corporations or businesses involved. **Here are some benefits of corporate membership:**

HOW IT WORKS:

A company pays or subsidizes dues for the primary regular membership fee per year (currently \$275), plus up to 2 additional alternate members based at 50% of the primary membership fee. The current RCRDE Membership fee is \$275 per annum; however, be sure to check with the club for any updates. Alternate members can attend club meetings in place of the primary member, but have no voting rights.

Since the primary corporate member is charged RI dues, that person is reported as the active member will receive the monthly Rotary Magazine, and will be listed on the club's membership roster. The alternate members aren't charged RI dues and are therefore not listed on the club's membership roster in Rotary's database.

Benefits to the primary member:

It provides more flexibility to the primary member because that person isn't required to attend every club meeting or event. Alternate members are exposed to Rotary, but aren't expected to attend all events.
