HONORABLE RUTH E. REUKAUF ON THE BENCH



Ruth E. Reukauf is a Superior Court Judge in Yakima County, appointed by Governor Locke in February 2004. Her current assignment is with Juvenile Court. She was previously appointed to the District Court Bench in 1995 as District Court Commissioner and was elected judge in 1998 and again in 2002.

Judge Reukauf has served as presiding judge for Yakima County District Court and Superior Court. She is currently serving as the SCJA Member on the Commission for Judicial Conduct (CJC) and was previously a member of the Gender and Justice Commission. She is also active in judicial education, having served as the chair of the

Annual Conference Planning Committee, past SCJA dean and past DMCJA dean of the Judicial College. She continues to serve as an educator in judicial trainings as well as going into the schools to speak with students about the law. Judge Reukauf is the keynote speaker for Evergreen Girl's State and served as a mentor for the College Success Foundation.

Prior to her appointment to district court, Judge Reukauf was a deputy prosecuting attorney for both King County and Yakima County Prosecutor's Offices. She specialized in handling crimes against children. Judge Reukauf received her undergraduate degree from Montana State University and her J.D. from the University of Puget Sound School of Law.
