LAURA CROOKS CHILDREN'S VILLAGE: 25 YEARS OF SERVING CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS AND A BRIGHT FUTURE AHEAD

Children's Village, the Valley's own center serving children with special healthcare needs and their families turned 25 this fall. Having served just over 600 patients in the first year, they have grown to serve over 9,500 patients just this past year, who accounted for over 43,000 visits. They now have over 30 different subspecialties that meet the needs of these children, their parents and caregivers, siblings, and the community. But did you know they are undertaking even more?

Laura Crooks, our own Downtown Rotary member, joined Children's Village in 2019 as their first CEO. She came to us from Seattle Children's Hospital where she spent the previous 25 years of

her career serving children such as those seen at Children's Village, serving in multiple leadership roles throughout the hospital. Since coming to the Village, a strategic plan was developed that included not only sustainability for the future, but also growth of services and a vision that highlights the compassion of our community to serve all children, even those who have special needs.
