Before taking over as an Assistant Superintendent, he served as the District Athletic Director for Vancouver Public Schools from 2007-15. As the athletic director at VPS, he developed a summer Coaches' Institute, a continuing education opportunity where coaches

throughout the district and southwest Washington had the opportunity to learn from medical and industry professionals. Mick also represented WIAA District IV on the WIAA Executive Board from 2016-18 where he was a member of the Classification Committee and chaired the WIAA Recruiting Committee.

Mick got his start as a language arts and social studies teacher at Fort Vancouver High School and Hudson's Bay High School in Vancouver, Washington. He has head coaching experience with boys' basketball as well as boys' and girls' golf.

He graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Education before earning a Master of Education all from the University of Portland.
