- Dates of project December 26th, 2007– January 9th, 2008
- Project location Mumboha Primary School, Luanda
- Renovations and improvements to Mumboha Primary School include:
 - Cement floors in 10 classrooms (previously floors were made of mud and cow manure) - complete
 - Plaster walls in 10 classrooms complete
 - Paint interiors of 10 classrooms (cream paint with black baseboards) – complete
 - Paint exterior of school to be completed by contractor (supplies unavailable)
 - Set up one room in school as library in progress (shelves have been erected)
 - Build sand volleyball court on school grounds in progress (poles are erected, pit dug out, waiting for remainder of sand to be delivered)
- Programmed activities with students
 - 2-3 hour activity sessions for all grade levels from KG to grade 8
 - Indoor activities included: letter writing, colouring, photos and frames, crafts, circle activities, story telling, dancing and singing
 - Outdoor activities included: relay races, soccer, Frisbee golf, skipping
 - Teachers participated regularly in programming
- Items donated to school and to school children:
 - 600 nylon Rotary backpacks
 - 120 canvas school bags
 - 800 t-shirts and golf shirts
 - 100 hats
 - 50 inflatable globes
 - 400+ library books
 - soccer balls, volleyballs, tennis balls, rubber balls
 - skipping ropes
 - volleyball net system
 - thousands of pens, pencils, erasers
 - hundreds of crayons, markers, pencil crayons
 - teaching aids (posters, borders, flash cards, etc)
