- St. Thomas Anglican School
  - Programmed activities with students
    - 2-3 hour activity sessions for all grade levels from KG to grade 8
    - Indoor activities included: colouring, photos and frames, crafts, circle activities, story telling, dancing and singing
    - Outdoor activities included: relay races, soccer,
    - Teachers participated regularly in programming
  - Items donated to school and school children included:
