TODAY'S PROGRAM

Dr. Jody Rappe, Chief Medical Officer, Beaumont GP

Dr. Rappe has been the chief medical officer and a patient safety officer at Beaumont GP Hospital (a Level 3 trauma center handling auto accident but not gun injuries) I since 2021 and is excited about all of the improvements that have been made and those that are scheduled to take place. She is also proud of the distinctions the hospital has received as well as the quality of nursing it attracts.

A \$19 million investment in surgical facilities has just been completed with state-of-the-art equipment included. A \$1.9 million Cath lab renovation is underway and construction on a special care (Level 2 NICU) nursey will begin later this year. The hospital has also purchased its second Da Vinci robotic surgical platform and a stealth neuro/Ent which provides increased visualization for neurosurgeries.
