Richard Martin, Detroit Zoological Society (DZS) Director of Individual Philanthropy

The DZS is a nonprofit organization that operates the Detroit Zoo and Belle Isle Nature Center. Its mission is to create meaningful connections between people, animals, and the natural world so call can thrive.

In 2024, the Zoo had 1,225,000 visitors and has an operating budget of \$54 million. In that year, the first gorilla, along with two rend pandas were born at the Zoo. It offers numerous education programs to schools and internships.

For the community, the Zoo offers many special days to children with terminal illnesses, sensory friendly mornings, and Senior Days. In 2026, the Zoo will open Discovery Trails which will "connect" people and animals, "gather" people together with seating, dining, and retail, and "play" which offers interactive structures for children to play on.
