TODAY'S PROGRAM

Phil Gilchrist, Executive Director, of
the Anton Art Center in Mt. Clemens.

The Anton Art Center is in Mt.
Clemens at a location that was
originally a Carnegie Library, which
was built in 1904 and is now listed on
the national registry. Over the past
few decades, the Art Center has
expanded while incorporating the
historic nature of the original building.

The galleries are almost exclusively
local artists, and it offers art classes
and artist talks. The pandemic
required the Center to become
creative, starting an online exhibit
within a week of the shutdown in
2020. It continues to offer virtual
programming with classes and an You
Tube channel.

Mr. Gilchrist believes it's very
important to make the building
available to the public, due to its
historic nature and how much better it
is to see the artwork in person. The
Center is now open for its 44th annual
Holiday Market, running through
12/23. Holiday items, fine art, crafts,
apparel, and much more are available
for purchase.
