## Children's Assistance Committee

### **Mission Statement and Mandate:**

- (a) Assist in providing aid to physically challenged children residing in the City of Windsor or Essex County.
- (b) Assist and collaborate with other persons and agencies endeavoring to promote the health and well-being of children with physical disabilities.



## Children's Assistance Committee

- The program is for children 18 years old and younger. At 19, they are part of the Adult Assistance program.
- There is a maximum funded of \$1500 per child per fiscal year.
