When does Rotary meet?

We meet every Monday at Noon at Westfield Center-2700 Westfield Trenton and every 2nd Monday at 6p.m. at Sibley Gardens-916 W. Jefferson Trenton.

How much are dues?

The membership dues are \$264/year. Corporate discount for an additional member is \$164/year and for a third member is \$140/year, plus lunches. Lunches are \$15/week. Bills are received quarterly in March, June and Oct. and Dec.

What Are “Happy Dollars”?

If you are happy give a happy dollar at the weekly meetings, it goes towards our fellowship fund for activities with members.

Is attendance required?

Not any longer, come when you can!

What would be asked of me if I join the club?
