



Frequently Asked Questions Becoming a Member of the Rotary Club of Trenton, MI

When does Rotary meet?

We meet every Monday at Noon at Westfield Center-2700 Westfield Trenton and every 2nd Monday at 6p.m. at Sibley Gardens-916 W. Jefferson Trenton.

How much are dues?

The membership dues are \$264/year. Corporate discount for an additional member is \$164/year and for a third member is \$140/year, plus lunches. Lunches are \$9/week. Bills are received quarterly in March, June and Oct. and Dec.

What Are “Happy Dollars”?

If you are happy give a happy dollar at the weekly meetings, it goes towards our fellowship fund for activities with members.

Is attendance required?

You are required to attend a minimum of 50% of the meetings. If you attend a club fundraiser or a committee meeting, this can count as a meeting as well.

What would be asked of me if I join the club?

Simply to give what you can. You will be asked to sit on a committee. You will find there are many opportunities to be involved and can pick those that best fit.

Will there be someone to help me along as I learn?

We will assign you a seasoned member to help you along the way.

Is the club involved in politics or religion?

Rotary is a nonpolitical, nonreligious organization.

How do I know if it is right for me before I make a commitment?

We invite you to attend three meetings as our guest. Take time to learn about our group and to see if it is a fit. After three meetings if you are interested you are welcomed into the club.
