

HAZEN PRICE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Introduction

This scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating high school student who excels in a field of science (see eligible fields) as well as contributes to the overall wellness of their high school community or the Town.

The award is named in honour of long-time Amherstburg Rotarian, Hazen Price. Hazen joined the club in November 1948 and had been an active member right up to his death December 2022. Hazen attended the University of Michigan where he earned his Master's Degree in both Chemistry and Botany. He used these degrees to assist him in operating a farm in Essex County.

After graduation, Hazen not only worked his farm but was also a supply teacher in Chemistry for General Amherst High School. During his time with Rotary, Hazen has been instrumental in the heritage preservation of the Park House as well as being instrumental in creating what we now know as the Gibson Gallery.

Amount of Scholarship

The Rotary Club of Amherstburg will award 1 prize of \$2,000.00 annually to the graduating high school student who best exemplifies Hazen's commitment to community service while maintaining high standards in education.

Eligibility

- Must be an Amherstburg resident
- Must be graduating from high school in the year of applying for the scholarship
- Must be pursuing post-secondary education registered and accepted into a Canadian university or college. The recommendation can be accepted from Principal or Guidance Councillors.
- Must have an 85% average minimum in the following scientific subjects:
 - o Chemistry
 - o Biology
 - o Physics
- Must have volunteered at least 50 hours during school events or volunteered for Town events/activities.
- Must submit a 500 word minimum essay on how this scholarship will help the applicant achieve her/his post-secondary goals, taking into account her/his post-education career goals.

Deadline

The completed application must be submitted to the Rotary Club of Amherstburg by May 15th of the year the applicant is graduating high school.
