BELLEVILLE ROTARY CLUB'S DONALD JUCHARTZ AWARD FOR COMMITMENT TO EXEMPLARY COMMUNITY SERVICE (for a community member at large, either a high school senior or community member who would like to return to school).

Belleville Rotary's highest honor recognizes community members who demonstrate Rotary's motto, *Service Above Self*, by volunteering their time and talents to help others and **commitment** to their community. This one-time Award is community competitive and is granted to no more than one (1) community member who resides in the tri-community area or a senior who attends VBPS, for a total of Five Thousand (\$5,000.) Dollars, for educational purposes.
