Update on

**Ecuador - Cervical Cancer - Hip Dysplasia project** 

According to international medical organizations Ecuador is a country with a higher than acceptable rates of cervical cancer and hip dysplasia. The vast majority of the population affected by these pathologies have little or no recourse for screening and treatment. With an effective screening program both pathologies can be reduced substantially greatly reducing costs to the Ecuador medical system and improving the quality of life for many less advantaged people.

There are 2 primary objectives for this project: 1) Vocational training & 2) Humanitarian aid. 1)Vocational Training: True North Mission (TNM) will train 5 gynecologists associated with the University of Azuay medical Department (UDA) as lead instructors in the etiology, diagnosis and treatment of cervical cancer using Visual Inspection of the cervix with acetic Acid (VIA) and subsequent treatment as appropriate with thermo-coagulation. TNM will use Curricula developed by the World Health Organization (WHO). TNM will also train 5 paediatricians in the etiology, screening and early treatment of developmental hip dysplasia.
