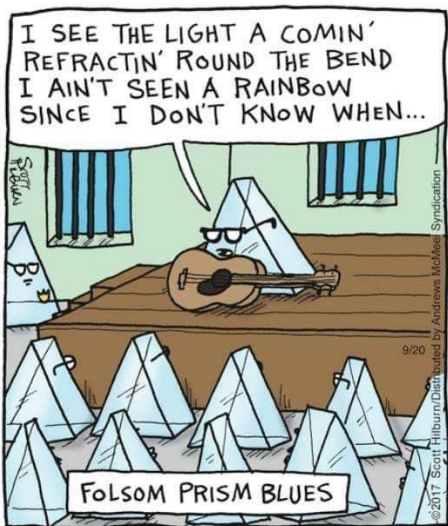
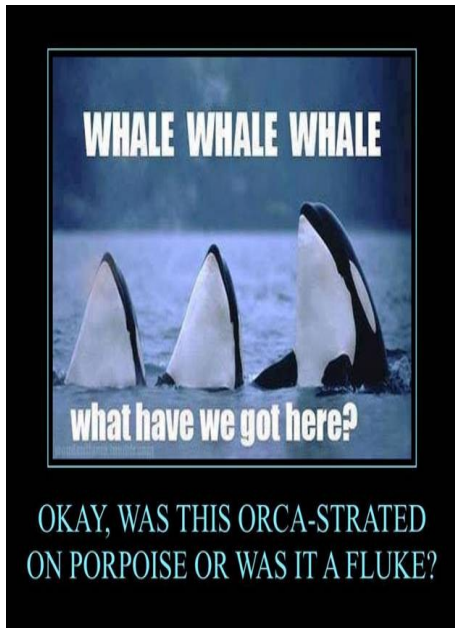

Steve Kim is the Executive Director of Access Youth Outreach Services Society, a grassroots non-profit serving at-risk and marginalized youth in the Tri-Cities. Since stepping into the role in August 2024, Steve has been leading the organization's vision to strengthen community connections and expand vital supports for youth and their families.

In addition to his work with Access Youth, Steve serves as a Coquitlam City Councillor, and volunteers on the Coquitlam Foundation Board and the Advisory Committee for Diversity for Joint Task Force Pacific - Canadian Armed Forces.

History of Access Youth

In 1993 PoCoMo Youth Services Society was incorporated, providing supports and services to youth ages 12 to 18 living in Port Moody, Coquitlam, and Port Coquitlam. In 2013 our agency expanded its services and programs outside of the Tri Cities and required a name that was inclusive to the new communities and youth we serve. PoCoMo Youth became Access Youth Outreach Services Society and continues to be an independent, community based charitable not-for-profit in the Tri Cities region.

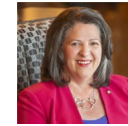
