

Children of the Street is dedicated to preventing the sexual exploitation and human trafficking of children and youth in British Columbia through education strategies, public awareness initiatives, and family support. Children of the Street is a program of PLEA Community Services Society of BC.

Sexual exploitation and human trafficking is the sexual abuse of minors and involves the youth being manipulated into exchanging a sexual act for money, drugs, shelter, food, transportation, love, acceptance or any other considerations. Victims can be of any age, gender, sexual orientation, income, geographic location or religion. Exploiters prey on the vulnerability of young people to exploit them.

We take a collaborative and comprehensive approach to preventing the sexual exploitation of children and youth. We know that investing in preventative measures means a decrease in the need for intervention and enforcement services, and is cost-effective over the long-term. We offer a variety of preventative programs which engage a diverse range of individuals and groups. Our primary prevention tool is education and awareness workshops – we facilitate over 500 workshops, in approximately 30 BC communities, reaching more than 25,000 participants annually!
