PACE® (Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly) is a program that helps people meet their health care needs in the community instead of going to a nursing home or other care facility. With PACE®, teams of health care professionals focus on the unique needs and circumstances of participants and their families to make sure they get the coordinated care they need.



Huron Valley PACE® allows seniors to remain independent in their own homes and communities.



In order to join the Huron Valley PACE® program an individual must:

- Be age 55 or older
- Be certified as meeting the State of Michigan criteria for nursing facility level-of-care
- Live within the Huron Vallev PACE® service area
- Be able to live safely in the community with the support of Huron Valley PACE®

Services provided through Huron Valley PACE® can include:


