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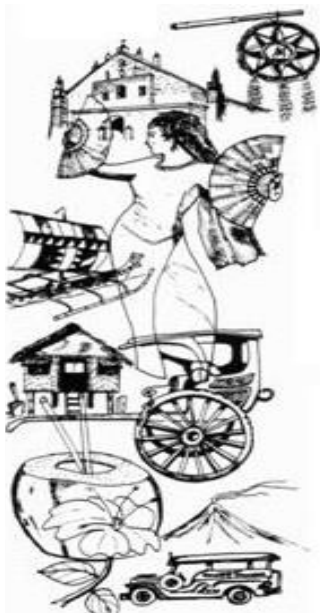
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Open Invitation to a Community Recital Concert

What is the Philippine Arts and Culture Ensemble of Michigan, PACE-MI ?

PACE-MI is a nonprofit organization based in Ann Arbor, Michigan; the IRS certification is provided on request. Our mission is to provide community-based educational programs and resources on Philippine arts and culture. We promote Filipino heritage through the learning of the Philippine Rondalla (a string ensemble), the Kulintang (a percussive ensemble), and the Traditional Folk Dances and Songs (expression ensemble). Our main learning outcomes include *ensemble concerts*, *group recitals* and *community workshops*. The coming concert is a large community recital that orchestrates the ensemble areas into one fundraising event.

As local parents and guardians, our main concern was the lack of a local ethnic community organization that sustains the teaching, the learning, and the appreciation of Filipino heritage. PACE-MI now serves this need.

PACE-MI experience is transformative - youth and adults perform practice sessions individually and collectively and learn cooperation and discipline; the youth engage in peer mentorship and gain self-confidence; and life skills are passed forward to future learners and teachers. Empowered youth taught adult and young learners alike, and arranged musical pieces. This year we have done over 400 hours of group lessons, involving a collection of over 40 instruments, 30 performers, and 40 families. We co-sponsored many community workshops with organizations within and outside the UofM.

The coming **PACE-MI Concert** is titled '**Hiyas ng Pilipinas (Gems of the Philippines), A Celebration of Philippine traditional dances, music and songs – A Community Affair**'. It will be held at Bethlehem United Church of Christ, 423 S 4th Street, Ann Arbor, MI 48104, on Saturday, 30 June 2018, 7:00pm.
