

OBUASI WASH PROJECT IN GHANA (SUMMARY)

It is with great pleasure that we come to announce that the Rotary Club of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, is starting a new water and sanitation project in Ghana (Global Grant #22-38088) in the communities of Obuasi and Kumasi. This Ghana clean water project will result in the addition of 50 new boreholes, 217 microflush household toilets and 267 micro-credit loans. It has a total cost of \$200,000 and will impact more than 41,000 lives.

To implement this impressive project, three Rotary Clubs are joining forces:

1. The Rotary Club of Obuasi (Host Club) represented by Mrs. Elizabeth Hamenoo;
2. The Rotary Club of Myrtle Beach represented by Walter Hughes (the Project Leader) along with District Governor Bob Gross of District 7770 who will be promoting the fundraising effort and finally,
3. The Rotary Club of Montréal (Canada) represented by Jean Gagnon will be making an impressive effort toward fundraising.

The grant will be submitted in September to TRF and fundraising will occur from September 2022 to February 2023. Helping with this effort is the following district (D7720) and many clubs in the following states (South Carolina, Texas, Virginia, Georgia, Florida, etc.) across the US and Canada. All communities involved will provide local leadership and labor and each one of them will raise over \$800 toward their borehole.
