



COMMUNITY PAUL HARRIS FELLOW

ABSTRACT

The Rotary Club of Belleville may present, on an annual basis, up to (3) three "Paul Harris Fellow" awards to individuals in our community who meet the criteria and most reflect the spirit of Rotary. This document contains both the criteria and the form for submitting nominations.

The Paul Harris Fellow is one of the highest honours a Rotary Club can bestow on a Rotarian, a community member, organization or group. This award acknowledges "Service Above Self" which has been demonstrated to the community, the nation and the world.

CRITERIA FOR CPHF:

1. The nominator shall be a member in good standing of The Rotary Club of Belleville.
2. The nominee shall be from the community and NOT be a current member of Rotary.
3. The nominee must be an individual, not an organization or group.
4. Nominees should exemplify the qualities and ideals of the Rotary Motto "Service Above Self" embodied in the spirit of Rotary and the Four Way Test:
 1. Is it the Truth?
 2. Is it fair to all concerned?
 3. Will it build goodwill and better friendships?
 4. Will it be beneficial to all concerned?
5. Nominations may be accompanied by letters of reference in support of the nomination.
6. Nominations must be submitted electronically or in writing to the person shown on this form by the set deadline. Incomplete applications will not be processed.





All proposed nominations will be screened by the Immediate Past President (PP) or designated Rotary Board representative (designate) to ensure they meet eligibility criteria. Any follow up required will be communicated to the nominator.

Nominations will then be evaluated by a Past President Advisory committee and up to (3) three individuals **may** be recommended for the "*Paul Harris Fellow*" award which will be presented in November, Rotary Foundation Month.

The Rotary Club of Belleville will review the recommendations at its October meeting.

Communication to the winning nominees, guests etc. will be confirmed through the Immediate PP/Designate.

Media coverage for the winners and the event will be coordinated by the Immediate PP/Designate in consultation with the Club's Public Relations lead.
