MASKS FOR QUINTE PROJECT INFORMATION

These masks are handmade, washable, and reusable. All masks have a filter pocket should you choose to add an additional layer. People have been using coffee filters or the heavier blue paper towels as filters. Filters are one time use and should be removed prior to wash. All masks should be washed before initial use and after every subsequent use. Adult masks have copper wire around your nose for a tighter fit. Make sure you make any adjustments when putting the mask on so you do not touch your face while in use. These are non-medical masks and do not replace social distancing and self-isolation.

How to donate and receive your mask

“Medical masks, including surgical, medical procedure face masks and respirators (like N95 masks), must be kept for health care workers and others providing direct care to COVID-19 patients.

Wearing a non-medical mask or face covering while out in public is recommended for periods of time when it is not possible to consistently maintain a 2-metre physical distance from others, particularly in crowded public settings, such as:

- stores
- shopping areas
- public transportation

Public health officials will make recommendations based on a number of factors, including the rates of infection and/or transmission in the community. Recommendations may vary from location to location.

Masks alone will not prevent the spread of COVID-19. You must consistently and strictly adhere to good hygiene and public health measures, including frequent hand washing and physical (social) distancing.”
