### Frequently asked questions: North Island Rotary Clubs - Community-wide PPE Drive

- Hospital reserves of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) are running dangerously low. If we see a surge of sick people with COVID (as other Canadian centres have seen), we could run out.
  - The supply chain is paralyzed at this point, with unprecedented world-wide demand.
  - Medical staff are collectively very frightened of running out of PPE
  - Without proper PPE, risk of contracting COVID while caring for these patients is not a matter of if, but a matter of when.
  - With a reasonable supply of PPE health care workers' lives will be saved.

• PPE donations requested (unopened or opened boxes OK):

Surgical masks (medical grade, with either a tie or elastic strap). No homemade masks at this time.	
<b>Eye protection &amp; face shields</b> (any medical grade goggles preferred, but robust protective eyewear used in industry could also work well)	
<b>Gloves</b> (disposable protective examination gloves - not latex dish gloves at this point. Especially looking for gloves with extended cuffs if possible)	
<b>Gowns</b> (disposable medical gowns preferred, but Dupont 'Tyvek' or 'Tychem' coveralls are great reusable protection - impervious coveralls)	
Head coverings / medical hoods (disposable hats or hoods preferred. 'Bouffant' style hats used in food preparation or salon applications also OK). No homemade hats at this time.

## What kinds of businesses also use personal protective equipment?

- Medical professionals (dentists, orthodontists, clinics, physio, massage, etc.)
- Veterinarians
- Construction (drywallers, painters, carpenters, handy people)

- Industry (mills, farms, research labs)
