Service Above Self: Tony Bennett, 1926-2023

Tony Bennett who passed at the age of 96 recently, was more than just an accomplished singer with an over 8 decade career. He was also a life-long activist and Veteran who helped liberate the notorious Dachau Death Camp during WW2 and took part in the Selma-to-Montgomery March in 1965. His Alzheimer's diagnostics also lead to more research about the disease due to his ability to still perform.
