3. The dress code is business/business casual.
4. Our club will provide a digital projector and screen. With at least a week's notice, we can arrange a computer, in which case we will need an advance copy of your presentation to ensure that it will run properly on our system.
5. A podium and wireless hand-held microphone will also be provided. We ask that you use the microphone at all times.
6. Two weeks before your scheduled meeting, please provide a topic or theme of your presentation, and a short bio for prior publication to all members and for use in your introduction.
7. You will have 20 minutes for your presentation including Q&A time.
