DIRECTIONS TO Aberdeen Rotary Pavilion
1399 Sargent Blvd, Aberdeen, WA 98520

From I-5 South from Seattle

- Take the Hwy 101/Hwy 8 Exit – Exit 104
- Proceed West toward Shelton/Aberdeen (approx 45 miles)
- Continue West on Hwy 12 (do not take the Hwy 101 exit)
- *You will pass:
 - ✓ The City of Montesano
 - ✓ Through Central Park subdivision
 - ✓ Chevron station (on left)
 - ✓ Fire Hall (on left)
- You will also see the Chehalis River to your left. Get in the left hand turn lane and take the left hand turn just before Petco and AT&T (part of the Gateway Mall).
- The Rotary Log Pavilion is visible from Hwy 12 and across the parking lot from The Tractor Supply Store.



From I-5 heading North from Portland

- Take Exit 88B (Aberdeen), just north of Centralia
- Continue West on Hwy 12 through the cities of Rochester & Oakville.
- At Elma, continue West on Hwy 12 toward Aberdeen.
- Follow directions from * as noted above

HINT: IF you pass Starbucks on your right or McDonalds and Walmart on your left...you have gone too far.
