Financial need is not a consideration. Besides a minimum GPA, academic record is not a consideration.

**Who is eligible:** High school seniors graduating in the spring, who maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, and who live and/or attend school on Bainbridge Island.

**Application requirements:** To be considered for the scholarships, *all* of the following must be *received* by the application deadline.

- Completed Rotary Club of Bainbridge Island Community Service Scholarship Application.
- Two letters of recommendation from community members or others familiar with your service activities.
- Unofficial copy of your most recent high school transcript.
- [Optional] Supporting documents, such as certificates, letters of merit, awards, etc.

All the documents listed above, including letters of recommendation, must be included with the application and transmitted together (preferably in a single PDF) via email to <a href="mailto:cgivans359@aol.com">cgivans359@aol.com</a>.

**Application Deadline:** Complete applications must be received by Rotary on or before March 22, 2019. APPLICATIONS INCOMPLETE AFTER March 22, 2019 WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

*Interviews*: Finalists will be notified and scheduled for a 30-minute interview. Finalists will be notified on or about April 11, 2019. Interviews will take place April 20, 2019. (Because of tight timelines and the need to schedule multiple interviews, alternate interview dates are NOT available.)
