



# ROTARY CLUB OF HAWKS PRAIRIE

## THE FINANCIALS and OTHER COMMITMENTS

By joining the Rotary Club of Hawks Prairie you are agreeing to certain financial commitments as well as commitment to the purpose and support of the club.

### Initiation Fee

Upon admission (induction) you will be assessed an initiation fee of \$25. This is a one-time fee and is payable upon your first day as a member.

### Annual Dues

Annual dues are \$200 per year. This amount is subject to change at the beginning of each fiscal year as costs to the club rise. Our fiscal year operates from July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year. All members are billed at the same time with dues becoming payable July 15<sup>th</sup>. Unless you happen to be inducted in the month of July, your dues will be prorated for the number of months left in the current fiscal year. For example, if you were inducted on October 12<sup>th</sup>, you would pay nine months worth of dues, or \$150. If you were inducted on October 20<sup>th</sup>, your first month of dues would fall into November (inductions from the 16<sup>th</sup> to the end of the month, the dues start date is forwarded to the next month). Lunches are \$13 each meeting. You may pay a minimum \$5 for attending without the lunch.

### Paul Harris Sustaining Member

The club has a goal for every member to contribute at least \$50 annually to the Rotary International Foundation which the club matches with an additional \$50 annually. This designates you as a "Sustaining Member". The \$50 can be donated during the annual dues billing and Rotary International tracks your contributions. When total contributions reach \$1,000, you become a Paul Harris Fellow.

### Other Commitments

- o The expectation is that you attend 100% of the meetings. However, for continued membership you need to attend at least 50% of club meetings. Your commitment can be fulfilled by making up your absences in the following ways: Attend another club's meeting, anywhere in the world. It is most convenient to attend a makeup at one of our local Olympia area clubs that are listed below. - o Attend a committee meeting or club fellowship event.
- o Visit the on-line club and get your makeup documentation printed out.
- o Be sure and report to the Club Secretary any make ups you have, and remember that a make up only counts if it's within two weeks of the missed meeting, before or after.
- o Become involved in club activities by joining one or more committees.
