

President Bob, every member of our Rotary family is very proud of you and we appreciate all the hard work you have done on our behalf. We look forward to following your sterling example in the coming Rotary year!



For our first Rotary Minute, it seems fitting to look at how Rotary started. Many of us joined Rotary because of its community building and global humanitarian focus, but we may not be aware of how it all began.



Rotary was founded in 1905 by Paul P. Harris, a Chicago attorney, who wanted to "foster the ideal of service as a basis of enterprise, to encourage high ethical standards in business and professions, and to promote a world fellowship of business and professional men." Paul Harris is still a driving force in Rotary, which can best be seen through the Rotary Foundation. In his desire for camaraderie among business associates, Paul approached three fellow business men who also worked in Chicago's Unity building. On February 23, 1905, an attorney from Wisconsin (Harris), a mining engineer from Illinois (Gustavus Loehr), a merchant tailor from Maine (Hiram E. Shorey), and a coal dealer from Indiana (Silvester Schiele) got together for lunch, and Rotary was born. By October, 1905, the original Rotary club grew to 21 members.

The name Rotary was chosen because they would 'rotate' between each other's offices for weekly business discussions. In 1912 the name became the International Association of Rotary Clubs; the present name was adopted in 1922.

One of the Rotary Club of Chicago's first service projects was to install public restrooms in downtown Chicago to attract women shoppers and boost the local economy. We've come a long way since then.
