

Cleanup area is Trosper Road/I-5 interchange including Off-ramp from I-5 northbound to Trosper, and right turn to On-ramp from Trosper to I-5 northbound. **Date of Agreement Renewal 28 February 2016.**

Preliminary Activities:

Determine Saturday to schedule, usually in February, May, August and November (required four times/year). Usually time period, 9-10:30AM.

Announce at club meetings at least two meetings prior to that Saturday; remind members of need to view WSDOT Safety Video. Briefly comment to club need for safety measures adjacent to highways. Video available from club website or website www.wsdot.wa.gov/operations/adoptahwy.

Enter cleanup event on club website with space for four signups. Remind club members of event at each meeting prior to that Saturday on schedule, wearing proper clothing with gloves, etc. Leader checks website signups and keeps club informed.

Group Leader obtains from Low Rents Store Friday afternoon prior two large orange, folding triangular signs "Shoulder Work Ahead" or "Workers Ahead", two folding aluminum kick stands and two orange traffic cones. To be returned to store Saturday afternoon after cleanup, approximate cost \$20.

Saturday or Work Day:

Group Leader arrives at parking behind Pho's Restaurant/Old Arby's ~8:40AM with bag of orange vests and second bag containing large plastic bags, WSDOT individual registration forms/pens, and box latex-free/powder-free plastic gloves. After arrival, participants will be reminded of highway safety issues, street crossings, etc. Leader insures Registration Forms are completed and maintained for file.

Plastic bags, collected debris, etc., will be stacked on east side of ramp approaching Trosper, just short of the sign "Welcome to Tumwater." Leader thanks each worker and collects orange vests.

Paperwork: Report completion and number of bags, amount of debris, etc., online to www.wsdot.wa.gov/operations/adoptahwy. Include copy of Volunteer Participant Activity Report for file. Make comment on relative success to club president.
