

Powell River Rotary Club Grant Committee Guidelines

Areas of focus:

Local Community

Youth

Elderly

International projects

All applications for grants will be received by the Secretary and then sent to the Grant Committee for recommendations, based upon the criteria. All applications will be looked at based upon their individual merit.

Requests for funding must be accompanied by:

Description of the project

Goals and objectives of the project

Benefits to those effected

Financing of the project and matching efforts/monies/in kind donation

Eligible applicants may include, but are not limited to:

Not for profit societies

Community organizations

Youth groups

Normally grant funding will be a onetime consideration by the Committee

Follow up requirements:

A summary of the project report after completion

A full accounting of all expenses and disbursements

Documentation of the benefits of the effort

Acknowledgement of the grant from the Powell River Rotary Club

Algorithm proposed:

Application received by the secretary and expressed to the Board. Application will then be sent to the Grant Committee for due diligence and determination of the merits. Committee recommendation goes back to the Board and the Board then accepts the recommendation and reports to the membership for their approval. If the Board rejects the recommendation of the committee then it should go back to the Grant Committee with rationale from the Board and possible reconsideration of the request.
