## IMPORTANT: CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Weather conditions can vary so it is advisable to have a water shedding jacket for possible rainy days. Also no sandals, flip flops, slip ons, croc's or other footwear that does not cover the entire foot. You will not be permitted to participate without proper footwear.

### **May 22, 2019 - Wednesday evening registration and student mixer**

This is a fun evening, so casual attire is appropriate. Sweatshirt or sweater could be good as the evening cools.

### **May 23, 2019 - Outdoor forest and environment field studies at Aleza Lake.**

For footwear we suggest hiking boots or sturdy sneakers. Also keep in mind it could be raining. Otherwise good, comfortable casual clothing will be fine with perhaps a sweatshirt or sweater. Long pants are essential as you would otherwise be susceptible to getting scratched.

We will have lots of mosquitoes for company. Insect repellent will be provided. It is also a good idea to wear long sleeved clothing. A light hoodie also can limit your exposure.

One of the activities on this day involves getting into a stream wearing hip waders which are provided. It is possible that water may get into the wader, so having a change of clothing along would be a good idea.

### **May 24, 2019 - Mill tours, nursery tour and College of New Caledonia**

For footwear we suggest hiking boots or sturdy sneakers as your day will involve climbing up and down metal stairs in the mills. Otherwise good, comfortable casual clothing will be fine

### **May 25, 2019 - Fire Attack Center and University of Northern British Columbia**

For footwear we suggest hiking boots or sturdy sneakers. Also keep in mind it could be raining. Otherwise good, comfortable casual clothing will be fine with perhaps a sweatshirt or sweater.
