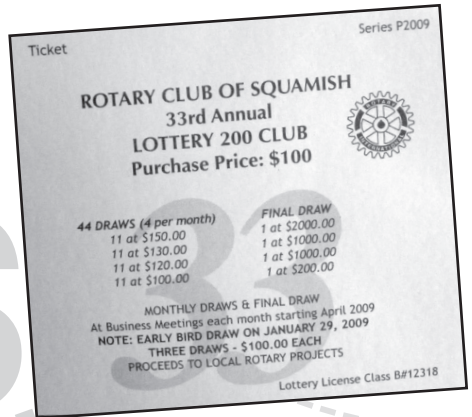
**Take a look at this ticket

This is a ticket for the **Rotary Club of Squamish 33rd Annual Lottery 200 Club**. The concept for the lottery started in the District of Squamish 33 years ago. The lottery money is divided between the ticket winners and local rotary projects in the community.

The ticket purchase price is \$100. There are 44 draws (4 per month) that are held at rotary business meetings each month starting in April 2009. The final draw holds the big dollar amounts and prize money for lucky winners could be as much as \$2000 or a break even dollar figure of \$100. As a ticket holder you have a great chance to be a winner many times. If your ticket is drawn it then goes back into the draw.

The **BIG WINNERS** are the **Squamish community** as the other half of the lottery proceeds goes into local rotary projects. Over the years, lottery generated dollars have gone into a variety of community projects i.e. the Library 2002, Breakfast program for school children, Christmas Care, Food Bank, Road Run 2002, gardening at Hilltop, Heart and Stroke, the West Coast Railway, Adventures in Citizenship, Dry Grad, District Diabetes and the Harbour Gazebo just to name a few.
