In Your Community

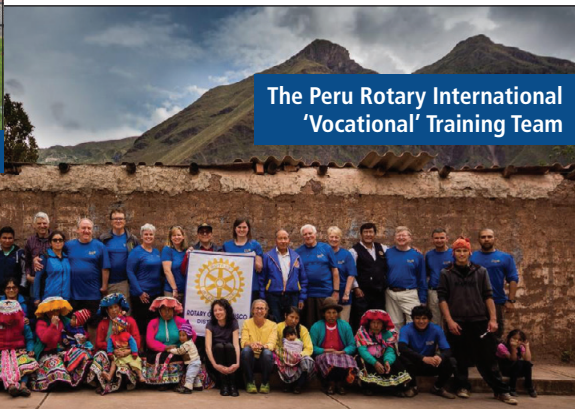
