They join with the other Rotary clubs in their area to put on a Ribfest that is held in July each year, and is one of their biggest fundraisers.

Ribfest started in 2015 and is held with volunteers from the members of other Tri-Cities Rotary clubs as well as hundreds of volunteers from the community. It is estimated that roughly 50,000 visitors attend the festival over the three days each year, with about 35 to 40% of those people coming from outside of Port Moody. There is live music over the three days and a "Fun Zone" with entertainment for children and families.
